

Precautions before Using the Printer:

1. Read and understand all instructions;

2. Familiarize yourself with the basic principles associated with operating electrical appliances;

3. Comply with all warnings and instructions marked on the equipment or specified in the manual supplied with the equipment;

4. If the operating instructions conflict with the safety information, please refer back to the safety information, as you may have misunderstood the operating instructions. If you cannot resolve the conflicts, please call the Customer Service Hotline or contact a service representative for help;5. Before cleaning the equipment, remove the power cord from the AC power supply outlet. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners;







3. Driver installation and uninstallation

3.1. Driver Setup

This device supplies driver setup applications for Windows and macOS. We recommend One-click installation, which helps you install the driver automatically in a faster and easier way. Should you encounter trouble when using the One-click installation, you may try more setup methods.

Note:• Driver installation interface may differ because of different models and functions, so the schematic diagram is only for your reference.

3.1.1. One-click Installation (For Windows and macOS)

One-click installation offers installation options via "Wi-Fi", "USB", and "Wired Network". You may select the one you're familiar with the most according to the connection methods supported by your printer.

3.1.1.1. Connect printer via Wi-Fi

Before installing printer driver, please check if your printer is connected to the Wi-Fi properly. If not, please follow <u>Section 3.1.1.1.1</u> for installation; and if yes, please follow <u>Section 3.1.1.1.2</u> for installation.

4.2.2. Set or Change Web Server Login Password

You can manage the printer through User Management.

Steps:

1. After opening the built-in WEB server, log in (default user name is admin, default password is 000000).

2. Click "User Management" to execute proper actions.

4.2.3. SNMP protocol setup

You can set the SNMP protocol through the SNMP interface to improve the network information security of the printer.

- 1. Turn on printer power to connect printer to network.
- 2. Log in the embedded Web server (please refer to Chapter 4.2.2 for login method).
- 3. Click "Setup" "Network Setup" "SNMP".
- 4. Check relevant SNMP protocols as needed, click "Apply".

Note: The SNMP protocol can improve the efficiency of network management, receive notification messages and warning event reports from network nodes, and help you discover and solve network issues in a timely manner.



5. Wireless network setup (applicable to Wi-Fi models)

Depending on model, the printer with Wi-Fi printing function supports the two types of wireless network connection of both infrastructure connection and Wi-Fi hotspot connection, while there is usually only one connection between computer and printer at a time. If you have problems during wireless network setup, please refer to <u>Chapter 5.3</u> Wireless Network Setup Frequently Asked Questions.



5.1. Basic structure mode

You can connect a computer to your printer via access point (wireless router) as the medium. Access point (wireless router) connection is divided into wireless network setup and Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS).

Note: The machine with the fax feature supports automatic search of wireless network through the printer's control panel to select the wireless network you desire and then input its password for connection.

Important: Before wireless network installation, you must learn about the service set identifier (SSID) and password of your access point in order to use them during wireless network setup. If they cannot be determined, please consult your network administrator or access point (wireless router) manufacturer.

5.1.1. Wireless network setup tools

If your computer has been installed with a driver and had been connected to wireless network, but the wireless network was changed, you can set it again with wireless network setup tools.

5.1.1.1. Preliminary preparations

- 1. Access point (wireless router).
- 2. A computer that has been connected to network.
- 3. A printer that has wireless network function.

5.1.1.2. Setup methods of wireless network setup tools

If the access point (wireless router) supports Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS), the Wi-Fi key on the control panel of printer and WPS key on access point (wireless router) can be pressed in order to connect the printer to wireless network.

- 1. The access point (wireless router) supports Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS).
- 2. A printer that has wireless network function.

5.1.2.2. Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) method

Note: • If the printer is in sleep mode, it can be woken up by pressing any key on the control panel of printer.

4. Press the WPS key on access point (wireless router) within 2min and then release it.

5. When the access point (wireless router) and printer start to connect, the blue Wi-Fi indicator of printer starts to blink. The blue Wi-Fi indicator of printer will be normally on after successful connection.

If the connection is not established after more than 2min, the printer will return to its ready state, the Wi-Fi indicator will be off and Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) connection will fail. If it is needed to connect again, please repeat steps 3-4 above.

5.2. Wi-Fi hotspot mode

You can establish a connection between a wireless network-enabled computer and a wireless network-enabled printer without using an access point (wireless route).

5.2.1. Preliminary preparations

- 1. Printer with Wi-Fi hotspot function.
- 2. Computer with wireless network function.

5.2.2. Wi-Fi Hot Connection

Before connecting the printer hotspot, enable the Wi-Fi hotspot function of the printer by tapping the "Wi-Fi" button on the printer panel.

Note: • Tap the "Wi-Fi" button on the printer panel, and the printer will automatically print the "Mobile device Wi-Fi connection guide page" for Wi-Fi connection of a mobile device.

5.2.3. Wi-Fi Hotspot Configuration

When the wireless hotspot of printer is active, the user can connect to it directly by searching. The wireless hotspot is enabled by default, and the default password is "12345678". The printer-specific SSID and password can be obtained from Wi-Fi Configuration Information Page, which can be printed out by selecting Print Wi-Fi Configuration. After establishing the connection, the configuration can be completed according to the Web configuration method.

5.3. Wireless network setup FAQs

1. The printer is not found.

• If the power of computer, access point (wireless router) or printer is turned on.

• If the computer is connected to printer with USB cable.

• If the printer supports wireless network connection.

2. SSID cannot be found when network is connected

• Inspect if the power switch of access point (wireless router) is turned on.

• The printer cannot find the SSID of the access point (wireless router) you need to connect, please check the SSID of access point and try to connect again.

• Every time when the setup of access point (wireless router) is changed, you must set up the wireless network of printer again.

3. Connection failure

• Please inspect if the safe mode and password of access point (wireless router) and printer is correct.

• Inspect the wireless receiving around printer. Signal receiving may be affected if the router is away from the printer or there is an obstacle between them.

• Turn the power of access point (wireless router) and printer off and then restart them and set up.

4. The following aspects should be inspected if the printer has problems while they are used in network:

• Inspect if the firewall software blocks communication. If the computer and printer are connected in the same network but they cannot be searched, the communication might be blocked by firewall software. Please refer to the user guide of firewall software to turn firewall off and then try to search the printer again.

• Inspect if the IP address assignment of printer is correct. You can inspect IP address by printing the network setup information page of printer out.

• Please refer to the following steps to check if printer and computer are in the same network: 1) Select "Command prompt" as shown below.

a. Windows 8/10 system: Select "Search" button in the Start Menu and input "Command prompt"in search bar, then press the "Enter" button in the keyboard.

b. Windows 7/Vista/XP system: click "Start" menu-"All procedures"-"Attachment"-"Command prompt ".

2) Input ping and your printer IP address in popup window, and press "Enter" button.

For example: ping XXX.XXX.XXX.XXX ("XXX.XXX.XXX.XXX" is printer IP address)

3) If RTT is indicated in the window, that is to say your printer and computer are in the same network. If RTT is not indicated in the window, please refer to <u>Chapter 5</u> to re-configure the printer wireless network.

Note: • Please refer to the user guide or consult the manufacturer for information related to access point (wireless router).

6. Mobile Print/Scan/Fax (for models with Wi-Fi function only)

G&G Print APP is a free application with mobile printing, scanning and faxing functions, allowing you to print or fax photos, files, pages and scan photos or files directly from mobile terminal. Your printer may not support all of above mentioned functions, so please select relevant function of G&G Print APP for use according to your printer type. Please be sure the application has been installed and connected to wireless network properly before use.

6.1.1. Operating systems supported

"G&G Print" App is suitable for Android 5.1-10.0 and iOS 9.0-14.0 system versions.

6.1.2. How to download G&G Print APP

How to download it for Android mobile device:

1. You can download it from its official website https://www.ggimage.com/ggprinter_app

2. You can use Google Play Store > Apps > to search G&G Print > Download and install.

How to download it for iOS mobile device:

Click the App Store icon > Search interface > input "G&G" or "G&G Print" in the search bar > Download and install on the interface of iOS device to download.

Only printers that support AirPrint function can realize AirPrint printing. Please check if there is AirPrint mark on the packaging of the printer, in order to identify if the printer supports AirPrint function.

6.2.1. Operating systems supported by AirPrint mobile print

Applicable to iOS 9.0 or higher versions.

6.2.2. Preliminary preparations

- 1. A printer that has wireless network function.
- 2. iOS device mobile printing.

6.2.3. How to use AirPrint mobile printing

The printing steps may varied by applications, taking PDF as an example for explanation.

- 1. Turn on printer power.
- 2. Connect the iOS mobile device with wireless network of the printer (Please refer to <u>Chapter 5</u> for how to connect).
- 3. Open the files you need to print in the format of PDF on the iOS device.



- 5. Tap "print".
- 6. Please make sure the G&G printer is selected.

If you select other printers (or no printer), please click printer option and then select your G&G printer.

7. Set printing parameters such as number of copies to print.

8. Tap "print".

7. General Settings

This chapter mainly introduces some general settings of the menu on the control panel.


7.1. System Settings

7.1.1. Toner Save Setting

Users can select Toner Save Setting to lower the cost of printing. When the Toner Save mode is "On", the output color of the copy will be lighter. Default Setting is "Off".

- 1. Press "Menu" button to enter the menu interface.
- 2. Press direction pad "▲" or "▼" to select "System Settings" and press "OK" button.
- 3. Select "Toner save set" by pressing "▲" or "▼", and press "OK" to enter the toner saving mode.

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
Note: • For non-Wi-Fi Model Printer, the Wi-Fi button works as one-key toner saving button.
 • When this menu is placed on the bottom interface of selecting "Close/Open", symbol "*" of the options displayed in the menu will not update in time after changing toner save setting via one-key toner saving button. Users need to go back to the previous menu to re-enter this menu, the changed Toner Save Setting information will be displayed.

7.1.2. Language Setting

"Language Setting" is used to select the language to be displayed on the control panel.

- 1. Press "Menu" button to enter the menu interface.
- 2. Press direction pad "▲" or "▼" to select "System Setting" and press OK button.
- 3. Press "▲" or "▼" to select "Language set" and then press "OK" to do language setting.

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

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7.1.4. Sleep Time Setting


Set the Sleep Mode to lower the power consumption. Sleep Time Setting allows you to select the idle time before the device enter into Sleep Mode. The default idle time is 1 minute.

3. Press direction key "▲" or "▼" to select "Sleep time set" option, and press "OK" key to set the corresponding sleep time.

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Note: • When the printer is in dormant status, you can wake it up just by pressing Power Saving button, sending print/scan/Fax task, or opening or closing the output bin.

7.1.5. Auto shut-off setting


"Auto shut-off setting" to set off condition and off delay of printer.



7.2. Network Settings

You can view or set the network status through Network Settings.


Some parts of the printer are still hot within a short time after use. When opening the front cover or rear cover to clean the parts inside the printer, please do not touch the parts in the shaded area as shown in the following picture, so as to avoid burns.



Note: • When removing the laser toner cartridge, put the cartridge in a protective bag or wrap it with thick paper to avoid direct light damaging the photosensitive drum.

7. Gently wipe the dustproof mirror of laser scanning surface with a cotton swab or a dry and lint-free soft cloth with a little alcohol.

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8. Clean the inside of the printer by using a dry and lint-free cloth to gently wipe the shaded area as shown in the picture below.

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11.2. Maintenance of Laser Toner Cartridge

11.2.1. Use and Maintenance of Laser Toner Cartridge

For better print quality, please use the original G&G laser toner cartridge.

Note: when using the laser toner cartridge, please pay attention to the following:

• Unless used immediately, otherwise, do not remove the laser toner cartridge from the package.

• Do not refill the laser toner cartridge without authorization. Otherwise, the resulting damage is not included in the printer warranty.

• Please store the laser toner cartridge under a cool and dry environment.

• Toner inside the laser toner cartridge is combustible. Please do not put the laser toner cartridge near any source of ignition, so as to avoid causing a fire.

• When removing or disassembling the laser toner cartridge, please pay attention to the toner leakage problem. In case of the toner leakage resulting in that the toner contacts with your skin or splashes into your eyes and mouth, please immediately wash with clear water, and consult a doctor immediately if you feel unwell.

• When placing the laser toner cartridge, please keep it away from the area reachable by children.

11.2.2. Service Life of the Laser Toner Cartridge

Service life of the laser toner cartridge depends on the amount of toner that print jobs require. When the LCD screen prompts that the toner is exhausted, it indicates that the cartridge life is expiring or has expired. To ensure the print quality, please timely replace with new laser cartridge.

11.2.3. Replace Laser Toner Cartridge

Note: Before replacing the laser toner cartridge, please pay attention to the following:

• The laser toner cartridge surface may contain toner. Please remove it carefully to avoid spilling.

• Put the removed laser toner cartridge on a piece of paper to avoid the toner from accidentally spilling.


• After removing the protective cover, please immediately install the laser toner cartridge into the printer, so as to avoid photosensitive drum damage caused by exposing to too much direct sunlight or indoor light.

• While installing the laser toner cartridge, do not touch the surface of the photosensitive drum so as not to scratch it.



12. Troubleshooting

Prior to handling common trouble, first check that:

- Whether the power cord is connected correctly and the printer is powered on.
- Whether all protective parts are removed.
- Whether the laser toner cartridge is correctly installed.
- Whether the output bin is fully closed.
- Whether the paper is correctly loaded into the tray.
- Whether the interface cable is correctly connected between the printer and the computer.
- Whether the correct printer driver is selected and installed properly.
- Whether the computer port is properly configured and is connected to the proper printer port.

12.1. Clearing Jammed Paper

Note: Remove the jammed paper in accordance with the following steps, close the upper cover and tidy the paper in the tray, then the printer will automatically resume printing. If the printer cannot automatically start printing, please press the button on the control panel.


